The Chocolate Lover's Guide to Shanghai Centre

Celebrate this Valentine's Day with the One You Truly Love - Chocolate!

There's something almost mystical about our relationship with chocolate, which is clear from the terms we like to use to describe it - "divine", "sinful", and "heavenly", just to name a few. In fact, the botanical name of the cacao tree (from whence we get cocoa beans, the main ingredient in chocolate) is Theobroma cacao, which literally means "Food of the Gods." When Columbus returned from his maiden voyage to the Americas, one of the treasures he brought back with him was the cacao bean. And during his later conquest of Mexico, the Spaniard Hernando Cortez discovered Aztec Indians drinking a brew made from the beans called "chocolatl." Montezuma reportedly served it as a royal drink in ceremonial golden goblets, consuming some 50 cups of it a day himself, believing that it was means to stay healthy and alert, as well as a sort of natural Viagra.

But it wasn't until the Spaniards started cultivating cacao beans back home that things started to really heat up for chocolate. They experimented with adding spices like cinnamon and vanilla, and then came the magic ingredient: sugar. And voila! The rest, as they say, was history.

In fact, cacao's new found home of Europe held an equally divine place for chocolate, at first confined to secrecy in Catholic Monasteries. The Spaniards kept this "heaven-sent" delicacy to themselves for nearly 100 years, but the secret was finally leaked to the rest of Europe when Spanish Princess Maria Theresa presented cacao beans as an engagement gift to Louis XIV. Soon chocolate was the rage of the fashionable Court of France. When the masses

started to get hold of it in the 17th century, chocolate became so popular that the Church decided it must be an evil temptation, and so they declared consuming it to be "a sin."

Undeterred by this moral outcry, the famous Italian seducer Casanova asserted that chocolate could win the heart of any woman - a theory that's still held to this day, as evidenced by the millions of heart-shaped boxes filled with chocolate, passed around the world in a never-ending attempt to woo our prospective mates. Scientific research actually supports this belief. Physicians claim that chocolate soothes the hormonal fluctuations in a woman's body, and psychologists suggest that it's a good way to pick up your spirits when you're feeling down, as chocolate releases endorphins (the "pleasure chemicals" that make us feel happy). If you need further proof of the power of chocolate's sensuality, just watch the on-screen chemistry between Johnny Depp and Juliette Binoche as they share a spoonful of warm chocolate sauce in the film Chocolat.

No doubt the Swiss are the biggest chocolate lovers,

spending an average of US\$206 per person per year on the dark stuff. China's rise in chocolate consumption has been growing steadily, as well, leading the world in 2010 with an impressive 18% increase over last year. But at just 146 million pounds of chocolate consumed last year, it's still just a fraction of the West. Americans devour an astounding 100 pounds of chocolate per second!

With all that chocolate in mind, I set out to see what chocolate wonders I could find, figuring that if I wanted to find the best chocolate that Shanghai has to offer, Shanghai Centre would be the perfect place to start.

The first stop was House of Flour (hoF), which just recently opened a small boutique carry-out store at Shanghai Centre a few months ago. As a self-confessed chocoholic, I've been a huge fan of hoF ever since they opened their location in Puxi on Sinan Lu, near Huai Hai Lu. It's a chocolate-lover's dream-come-true, packed to the gills even late at night with chocolate werewolves like myself, digging into such sweet temptations as the "Chocolate Sins", a lavish dessert plate "for three sinners." I confess to committing the mortal sin of having eaten one all by myself...

perspective on chocolate. Soon I was practicing my less-than-impressive French skills with The Portman Ritz-Carlton's Pastry Chef Thierry Metee, a native of Brittany, and a recent arrival to Shanghai.
